100% Compostable

Made from polylactic acid (PLA) which is derived from corn starch, instead of the usual petrochemicals which formulate plastic, they are fully compostable and perfect for outdoor events.

Carry the CE mark

They are also the first disposable tumblers in the UK to carry the CE mark. The CE marking certifies that a product has met rigorous EU health, safety, and environmental requirements, which ensure consumer safety. It also means that unlike ordinary disposables, bartenders do not need to use measured beer pumps and licensed premises can comply with the 2006 Measuring Instruments Directive (MID).

'Smash-proof'

The nature of the materials used in these glasses also means that they are totally 'smash-proof' and don't splinter, meaning they cannot conceivably be used as weapons and cannot be harmful around small children or through excessive alcohol indulgence!
